Etisalat Afghanistan Terms of Reference For Logistics & Custom Clearing Agent

Etisalat Afghanistan (hereinafter referred to as “Etisalat”) hereby solicits your proposal for the provision of services of Logistics and Custom Clearing Agent as per below mentioned scope of work and terms and conditions:

Scope of Work:

Etisalat Afghanistan imports various GSM equipment, scratch cards, SIM Cards, other network related equipments, etc. for its Afghanistan operation on CIF, CIP, CFR and FCA, FOB basis. For custom clearance at import stage, Etisalat needs the services of custom clearance agents/companies who can provide the complete logistics and custom clearance services including documentations etc.

Firms having branches all over the country (Afghanistan) are requested to submit their proposals as per below:

Requirements for Qualification:

The proposal must meet the following minimum threshold requirements before it will be evaluated by the evaluation committee. If these threshold requirements are not met the proposal will not be considered.

1. Company Profile:

The firm must submit a brief company history, the legal name under which it conducts business, the name of its CEO, its mailing address, telephone numbers, fax numbers and its email address. In addition, the firm must



describe the locations/addresses of all its offices in Afghanistan. It shall also indicate whether the firm is a Sole Proprietorship, a company, partnership, joint venture or any other form of legal association.

a. If the firm is a partnership, joint partnership, or any other form of legal association, provide information about the country and date of partnership and list of all partners.

b. If the firm is a subsidiary of another organization, information about the parent organization e.g. legal name under which it operates, name of its Chief Executive, contact details, as well as information about the legal relationship between the firm and the parent organization.

2. Registration with Etisalat:

Firm must be registered with Etisalat Afghanistan (Vendor Registration Form attached).

3. Registration Documents:

Firm must provide copies of the legal documents verifying its legal entity and status, including the country and date of incorporation.

4. Age of the Firm:

Firm must provide evidence that it has been operating for a minimum of **Two years** immediately prior to 1 May 2008. In case of a joint venture or partnership or any other form of legal association, any one of the entities may qualify the firm by its having operated for a minimum of **two years** prior to 1 May 2008.

5. Past Performance:

Firm must describe past performance on similar public and or private agency contracts, including past performance on similar works for any other telecom company.



6. Reference:

In order to verify satisfactory past performance, the proposal should also include three references from major public or private companies, or private agency clients for whom the firm has provided services within the past three years with the name, title, address of the owner or manager with whom the firm worked.

7. Penalty:

Firm must make a statement confirming that if awarded a contract, it may be liable for penalties as per contract if failed to perform contractual obligation.

8. Rate must be quoted clearly in Afghani only

9. Proposals must be submitted in Sealed Envelope to Etisalat Afghanistan not later 27-May-2010.

10. Etisalat Afghanistan reserves the right to accept any or all proposals or cancel the tender at any time without any liability from proposals.

11. Vendor/tenderer must sign each page of this document and return it with proposal.
